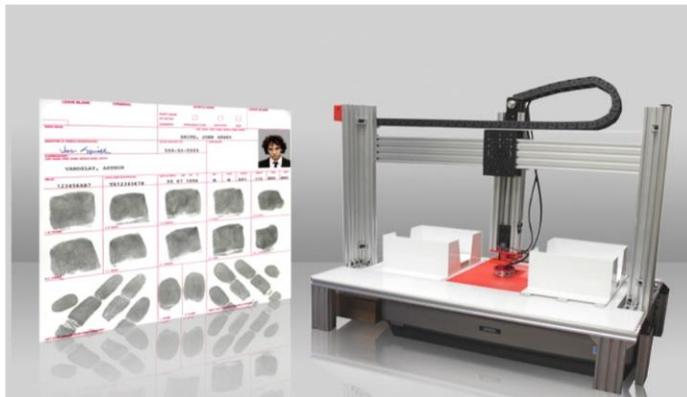


Mentalix Demonstrates New ADF R3 Feeder at IAI

Since that time, Mentalix has incorporated this device into its card conversion center and now the device is scheduled for presentation at the Annual IAI International Forensic Education Conference in Cincinnati, Ohio, August 7-13, 2016. The device is currently the only practical feeder-based solution available for volume certified fingerprint card scanning. Mentalix Completes Large Northwestern State Card Conversion Job

Mentalix recently completed a state-level conversion project that totaled well over a half million cards processed. Updated Fingerprint Image Quality Assessment using recently released NFIQ 2.0

Mentalix has upgraded its Image Quality Assessment using the most recently technology release provided by NIST for Fingerprint Image Quality (NFIQ 2.0). According to NIST, NFIQ 2.0 provides a higher resolution quality score (in range of 0-100 according to the international biometric sample quality standard ISO/IEC 29794-1:2016 [6] as opposed to 1-5), lower computation complexity, as well as support for quality assessment in a mobile platform. The updated functionality adds immediate, noticeable benefit to the operator in providing quality scores that are more accurate and much less likely to flag prints that are of acceptable quality. The increased accurate alignment of quality assessment with the practical use of fingerprints in automated identification systems reduces operator effort and knowledge required in getting the highest quality results.

Fed Submit 3.1 Archive Station

Mentalix's **Fed Submit** low cost Archive Station stores up to 70,000 transactions that can be imported automatically using industry standard EBTS files generated from your existing card scan station, live scan station, AFIS, ULW, or other biometric compatible system. The archive system supports easy demographic data searches as well as local fingerprint/palm print identification matches. You can use your latent fingerprint photos and photo capture files to do finger print and/or facial searches in the archive database. The Archive Station works with third-party manufacturer products while enabling the end user to take full advantage of electronic information. Even third party digitized fingerprint card transactions can be easily loaded, enrolled, and indexed within the system. Additional workstations can be added that share single database. Live scan capture device, camera, card scanner, transaction annotations capability, increased transaction count, and many more options can be added to the system as needed.

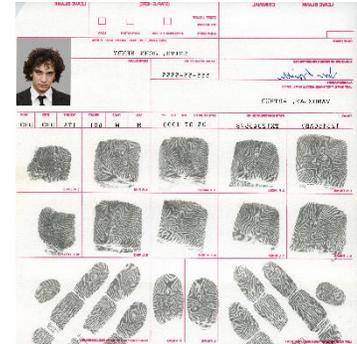

Mentalix has had an abundant amount of customer interest in card conversion – conversion of historic paper fingerprint cards to electronic format for storage and retrieval in their Fed Submit database. Some of our customers have purchased additional card scan stations and they are using in house or volunteer labor to complete the card conversion process. This is a very economical route, but rate of doing manual card scan - a single card at a time - is extremely limited. Mentalix operates a bulk card conversion center to expedite the card conversion process. In addition, Mentalix is now offering a joint labor option to make this opportunity more economical to our customers. Instead of Mentalix doing preparation (including barcoding) and data entry work, Mentalix now supports a card conversion flow that allows you to optionally take on these labor intensive tasks in house and at your own pace and with in-house resources. Data entry can be performed incrementally with your in-house labor resources even after card conversion is fully completed. This enables fingerprint images to be available for matching within the customer system immediately after the conversion process. The new card conversion option allows Mentalix to offer a considerably more practical and cost-efficient per card pricing model.
